AMBULANCE NEWS

The Babinda Ambulance will have a big focus this year on community CPR – Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation. Studies have shown that survival for out of hospital cardiac arrest (basically having your heart stop anywhere else except in a hospital) is greatly enhanced by people knowing how do CPR in the community. The reason for this is that if you can do effective CPR on a person until professional help arrives you can keep oxygenated blood pumping around the body. The heart and brain need that oxygen which is carried through the blood. Watch this space throughout the year to see how you can be involved. There will be no cost and it will not take up much of your time. At the Christmas in Babinda activity in early December we set up a stall and a few people had a go. Unfortunately like everyone else that massive storm cell put an end to the night way to early. Thankfully no one was struck by lightning as it cracked all around us.

The Christmas/School holiday period has been extremely busy for us, fortunately there have been no major accidents. Dr Renee from the hospital will be on maternity leave soon and her dedication will be missed for those months. Babinda is extremely lucky to have such a great team of doctors at the hospital with Renee, Tanya and HB. The nursing staff and support personnel make a wonderful team and keep the hospital strong. For a little town Babinda is extremely lucky and the envy of many towns the same size and larger. You can see the commitment from members of the community to the Babinda Hospital Advisory group everyone gives up their free time to improve the services on offer and that extra effort means Babinda resident get even better care and services. It's the same with the community CPR we are trying to drive at the moment, it's a bit hard to things with a small amount of people but with a few extra hands from the LAC members we can get a lot done.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH Method February 2015 Chop garlic, shallots and onions finely. **Garlic Prawns** Add to wok when melted butter is foaming. 1 kg green peeled prawns Toss until soft, remove and set aside and keep warm. ½ knob garlic (approx. 6 plus bulbs) Melt extra butter in wok and add green prawns. Stir for approx. 5 mins till cooked. 1 bunch shallots (approx 8) Remove from heat and add cream. 2 onions Place mixture back onto heat and cool till thick, 2 oz butter then add the onion and shallot mixture. ½ carton of thickened cream Serve immediately with rice.

AROMATHERAPY- Are you finding it hard coping with the humidity, heat, even the air? Spritzing is a very clever way to assist with the uncomfortable feeling of being too warm. Spraying arms, legs or feet, avoid spraying the face due to eye contact. For your face, dampen a cloth and lightly apply to the back of the neck, behind ears and cheeks. A little essential oil can go a long way so resist adding more. Especially when using peppermint essential oil as more than a drop or two can have the opposite effect causing you to feel very warm instead. There are many essential oils you can choose from that can be added to distilled or mineral water. Here are a few suggestions. They will cool and relax you **Lavender, Eucalyptus, Peppermint, Geranium, Roman Chamomile, lemon and spearmint**, used individually or by blending 2 or 3 essential oils together. **Measurements -** 10/12 drops of essential oils to 125 ml chosen water. Shake well before spraying. Use glass or PET plastic spray bottles to mix your sprays in as essential oils can deteriorate other types of plastic.

OUTDOORS WORKING- add fresh mint from your garden to your water bottles this helps to cool your blood down which cools your body.



Resident evacuation & recovery register:

for residents of the Cairns Region who are elderly, infirmed and/or disabled and have no transport or friends or family in the area.

If an evacuation is required, those listed on the register will be assisted by emergency service personnel to evacuate their residence. In this event, evacuees will be taken to a safe designated area. Unfortunately emergency services will not have the resources to assist with moving large quantities of personal belongings or pets (except seeing-eye dogs).

This register is updated annually. By placing your name on the register, you are authorising Council to give your details to any agencies that may be involved in an evacuation.

If you answer yes to all of the following questions, you may qualify for the register:

Are you elderly, infirmed and/or disabled?

Do you have no transport?

Do you have no friends or family in the area? If you believe that your personal circumstances qualify you to be placed on the register, please contact:

BABINDA HOSPITAL MPHS NEWS





Greetings from the staff and Volunteers of the Babinda Bargain Centre,

Sadly over the Xmas period we experienced theft from our 'donation area' at the rear of the store. Opportunistic thieves were rummaging through donated items left on the back table overnight. Of course this was reported to the police.

What saddens me most is that if someone is in genuine financial distress and they need help, they simply had to ask for help we would have gladly assisted – especially if there are children involved. None of us here want to see kids going without bed linen, a clean towel or a school uniform and school bag to go to school with etc.

So whilst we are still in need of quality donations, please be aware if they are left on the table over night, they may be thieved. If possible, please put your donated items into the blue bins. If this is not possible because they are too big or fragile, please call us at the store and I will organise pick up from your house or business. Alternatively they can be dropped to us during our business hours if that suits you.

Things we cannot accept as donations include-

Baby car seats with anchor points

Strollers and cots

Any items stained with blood or body fluids

Anything obviously broken that cannot be repaired

We only accept beds on inspection – please do not leave a bed or mattress without our acceptance – this often creates a huge amount of un-necessary work for our Volunteers.

If in doubt about something you would like to donate, please give us a call at the store to discuss.

Please also note, the store will be closed on Friday the <u>27th March and Saturday the 28th March 2015</u>. With plenty of warning now, it gives all our regular shoppers a chance to get in early and avoid our closure period.




